

Disaster Event – North East Queensland Monsoonal Rainfall and Flooding, 7 – 9 February 2014



Event and Timing –

A westward moving surface trough, combined with an active monsoon, resulted in heavy rainfall and flooding occurring between 7 – 9 February 2014 in North East Queensland.

Assistance Activated –

The Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services, The Honourable Jack Dempsey MP activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).

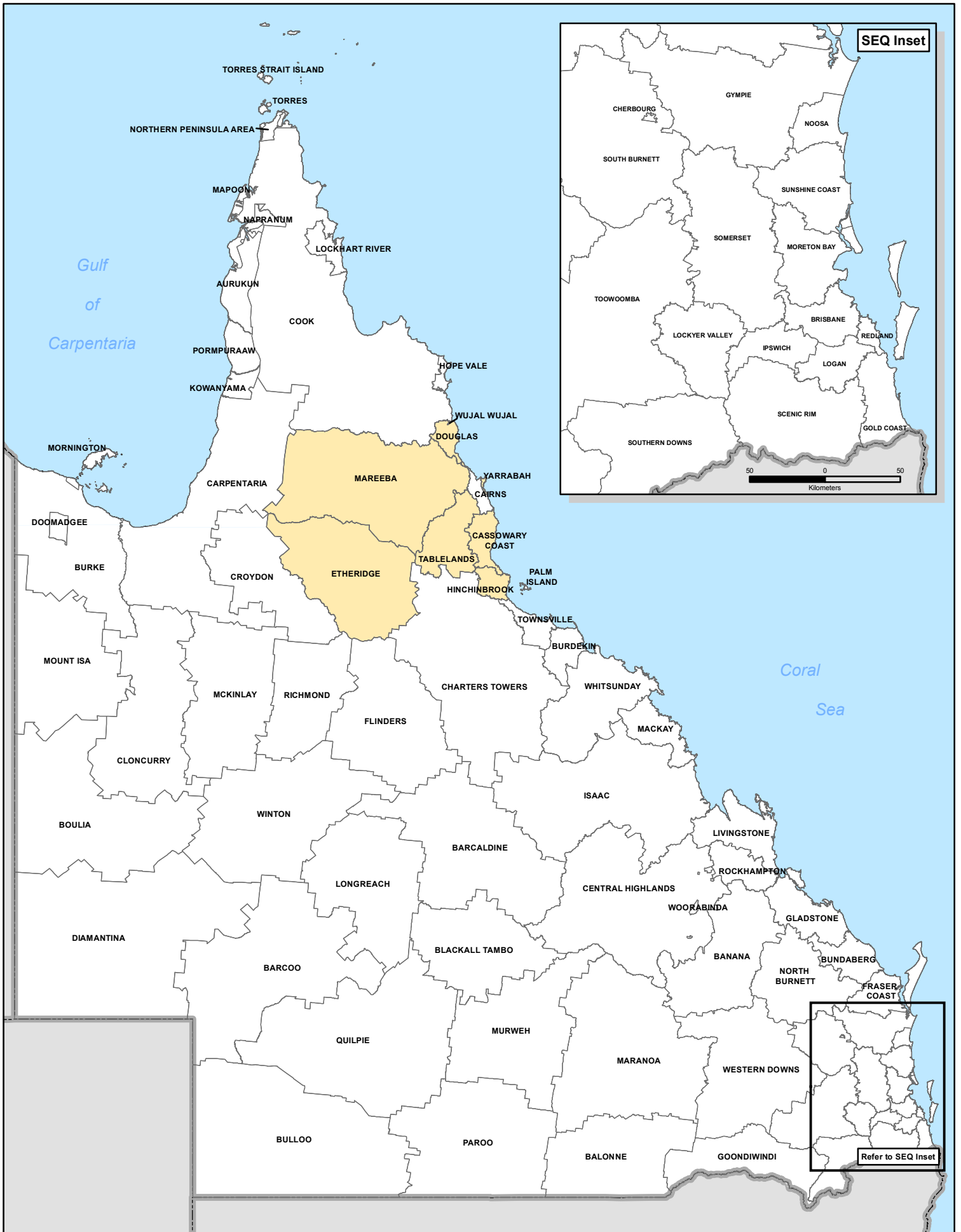
NDRRA Relief Measures Activated

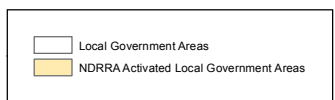
